

Diocesan News

EPISCOPAL ORDINATION OF VERY REV. FR. DANIEL FINDIKYAN

The Eastern Diocese is pleased to announce that a date has been set for the episcopal ordination of the Diocesan Primate, the Very Rev. Fr. Daniel Findikyan. His Holiness Karekin II, the Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians, has confirmed that, on the weekend of May 11-12, 2019, he will consecrate Fr. Findikyan as a bishop of the Armenian Church, in a solemn ceremony at the Mother Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin, in the Republic of Armenia.

Fr. Findikyan was elected as the Diocese's 12th Primate on May 4, 2018, by the delegates of the 116th Diocesan Assembly. His election was blessed and confirmed by the Catholicos of All Armenians on May 8. Fr. Findikyan is the first clergyman born in America to serve in the capacity of a diocesan primate, and he will be the second American-born clergyman to be elevated to the episcopate.

The Primate will return to New York to celebrate his *antranig badarak* (inaugural Divine Liturgy) as a bishop in St. Vartan Armenian Cathedral, currently scheduled for Saturday, May 18. A reception for the public will follow.

Consideration is being given for a group from St. Peter Armenian Church to travel to New York City for this service. Whether we carpool, rent a passenger van, or charter a bus, will be determined by the number of those who may be interested in going together as a group. If at all interested, please let Fr. Stepanos or the St. Peter Church office know so we may plan accordingly. Then more details will be announced in the future.



A Message from the Parish Council

Did you notice? Sometime during the first week in December, our altar curtain came down. It had not been working properly for many months. It would not close completely and a deacon would often have to manually rearrange the drape to close the gap. Over the years, a number of repairs have been made to the curtain; however, it had reached a point where the fabric had become too frayed. It simply needed to be replaced!

Parish Council member, Patty O'Keefe, took on the task of finding a suitable replacement. She consulted with Proctor's Theater and learned of who made their theater curtains. That led Patty to a firm in Queensbury who agreed to take on this project. In order to get the same cross embroidered on the new curtain, our curtain was removed and shipped to Georgia. It is there that a laser image of the cross was scanned and transferred to the new material so that the embroidering could begin. It is expected that the new altar curtain will be in place well before the upcoming Lenten season.

In 2016, Father Daniel Findikyan wrote, "For worshipers in the Armenian Rite, the closed curtain practically defines Lent. Strange as it may seem, nothing is more natural to an Armenian than coming to church on a Lenten Sunday to worship in complete visual isolation from the Eucharist ..."

The perfect ending to this story came from the Bardakjian family. They were looking for a memorial opportunity to remember our beloved Deacon Hrant. When Der Hayr shared with them the need to replace the altar curtain they agreed that the new curtain was a perfect memorial for Deacon Hrant.

As we approach the Lenten season, take a moment to appreciate our new altar curtain and to remember Deacon Hrant Bardakjian.

Kitchen Renovation Project Update

Additional donations and pledge payments continue to come in for the Kitchen Renovation Project. We are very close to completely paying off the total expense of our newly renovated kitchen equipped with new appliances, storage, and work space. In addition to donations and pledges, monies have been and continue to be raised in a variety of creative ways, such as through AmazonSmile, RoundUp, and Clynk.

Of these three fundraising efforts, RoundUp has proven to be the most lucrative so far, raising \$269.17 since its launch in October 2018, with only eight parishioners having registered. 




